Comments on this part of the Neighbourhood Plan

Thank you for including as a priority in paragraph 8.21 our previous comments concerning our current (and hopefully continuing) use of part of the site (land at 1 Hampton Road) for our community boat. Our charitable objectives are "to operate a community boat with (inter alia) free or subsidised use by disabled and less privileged members of society and to promote the interests of the waterways on which the boat will operate" and specifically support paragraphs 4,5 and 6 of SPA 14. Not only do we provide trips for local residents, and in

particular care homes, we also support tourism by also providing trips to visitors to the area and canal groups from other parts of the country. Our needs are for a secure mooring for our electric powered boat, storage for our ancillary equipment and meeting space along with car parking. As you also mention the town's gas works was once housed on the site, and the slipway is still used for launching boats to carry out maintenance work on the canals and also by the Fire Brigade for water rescue training. Hopefully these community uses can be supported for this part of the site. We also support the provision of a museum to feature the history of the Droitwich canals including their role in the salt trade.
